

# Go handmade

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#### YARN USAGE

Chain with bobbles: 50g Chain with lace: 50g

#### **MATERIALS**

Seleclips O-ring Pacifier ring

Crochet hook: 2,0 - 3,0 mm

The given amounts of yarn are for guidance only.

#### ABBREVIATIONS AND DEFINITIONS

Stitch(es) st(s) ch Chain stitch Double crochet dc sl st Slip stitch tr Treble 2 dc tog Decrease (2 dc worked together) Bobble stitch. \*Wrap yarn around the bst hook, insert the hook into the stitch, wrap yarn around the hook, pull the yarn through the stitch, wrap yarn around the hook and pull the yarn through the 2 loops on the hook\* x 4, for a total of 5 unfinished trebles. Finish by turning the hook over and pull the yarn through all the stitches on the hook. t-ch Turn chain stitch, 1ch then turn the work.

The instructions shown between these stars must be repeated for the whole round/row or with the number indicated after x.

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When making handcrafts and homemade things for babies, it is important to be careful with the assembly/mounting of the parts. It is particularly necessary to be careful with knots and loops.

#### PACIFIER CHAIN WITH BOBBLES

Crochet in rows (back and forth).

Cast on 7 ch (leave a long tail to sew on the O-Ring/Pacifier ring later)

Start in the 2nd ch from the hook and crochet 6 dc, 1 t-ch.

#### MOUNTING

end

The outer part without bst (bobble stitch) of the pacifier chain (row 1 - 7, approx. 2 cm) is pulled through the O-Ring/Pacifier ring and sewn together.

The selectip is mounted the same way at the opposite

Finish and leave approx. 25 cm of yarn to sew.

NOTE: The pacifier chain must measure a maximum of 22 cm incl. the seleclip and the O-Ring/Pacifier ring.



#### PACIFIER CHAIN WITH LACE

Crochet in the round.

- 1.) Cast on 50 ch.
  (leave a long tail to be able to sew on
  the O-Rina later)
- 2.) Start in the 2nd ch after the crochet hook and crochet 49 dc, 2 ch.
- 3.) Crochet 5 tr in the first st on the opposite side of the ch chain, \*skip 1 ch, 1 sl st in the next ch, skip 1 ch, 4 tr in the next ch\*; repeat to the last ch of the ch chain. Crochet 8 tr into the last ch.

There are 13 ch bows on the pacifier chain.

4.) Crochet the opposite side of the chain in the same way (sl st and tr on both sides must lie opposite to each other):

\*skip 1 st over, 1 sl st into the next dc, skip 1 dc, 4 tr in the next st\*; repeat to the last dc of the ch chain.

Crochet 2 tr into the last dc.

Crochet 1 sl st into the 1st tr from the 3rd

Finish and leave approx. 25 cm of yarn for sewing.

#### MOUNTING

The outer part of the pacifier chain (approx. 2 cm) is pulled through the O-Ring/Pacifier ring and sewn together.

At the opposite end, the seleclip is mounted the same way.

NOTE: The pacifier chain must measure a maximum of 22 cm incl. the seleclip and the O-Ring/Pacifier ring.



## Good to know

### Hook Size & Tension

Crocheters crochet very differently: some crochet with a hook size 2,0 mm and obtain the same size of design and quality as a person who crochets with a hook size 4,0 mm. We owe this knowledge to the team of crocheters who join us. The key to crochet a specific size is a lot about the crochet style/hands/skills, rather than the size of hook. Therefore, we will recommend a range of hook sizes.



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
