MATERIALS:

DORTE – ON WOODEN RING

Yarn - Soft Bamboo "Double":

15 g white
5 g grey
2 g black
2 eyes 6 mm
Wooden ring 68 mm
Toy stuffing
Crochet hook 2,0 - 3,0 mm

DORTE (3 PCS) & BEADS

Yarn - Soft Bamboo "Double":

35 g white
12 g grey
12 g black
6 eyes 6 mm
Wooden beads 20 mm
Polyester string
Toy stuffing
Crochet hook 2,0 - 3,0 mm

All yarn lengths are estimates and depend on crocheting style.

ABBREVIATIONS AND DEFINITIONS

dc	Double crochet
2 dc inc	Increase (2 dc in 1 st)
dc 2 tog	Decrease (2 dc worked together)
htr	Half treble
chain	Chain stitch
st(s)	Stitch(es)
cr	Centre ring (2 ch, work the specified number of stitches into the second stitch from the hook)
sl st	Slip stitch
tr	Treble
t-ch	Turn chain stitch, 1 ch then turn the work
{...}	The instructions shown in these brackets must be repeated for the whole round/row.
(..)	At the end of the round/row
-	indicates the total number of stitches.

If not indicated otherwise, work in spiral rounds. Close the last row with a sl st, cut the yarn (leave 20 cm hanging) and pull through the stitches.

REQUIRED MOUNTING STEPS

Eyes in yarn projects (0-3 years)

For projects for children 0-3 years:
Mounting of eyes requires melting of end pieces and special stitching.

DORTE – ON WOODEN RING

HEAD (GREY/OFF-WHITE)

Start with grey.

Insert the eyes after 12th row with a distance of 7 sts in between.


Fill the head with toy stuffing.



Close the hole by pulling the yarn with a darning needle through the 6 sts.

Shape the head/eye sockets:

Insert the needle beneath the head and up the inner side of the eye. Sew over a stitch at the eye stem, and lead the needle out beneath the head. Then, insert the needle through the next stitch and up the inner side of the other eye. Again, sew over a stitch at the eye stem, and once again, lead the needle out beneath the head. Tighten the thread, allowing the tension to create indentations. Hold the tension and tie two knots to preserve the indentations. The eye sockets are done. The shaping of the head/eye sockets can also be done before the eyes are mounted.

EAR (OFF-WHITE/BLACK, 2 X)

Second ear: crochet the 4 first rows in black!

- 1.) cr with 4 dc (4)
- 2.) {1 dc, 2 dc inc} (6)
- 3.) {2 dc, 2 dc inc} (8)
- 4.) {3 dc, 2 dc inc} (10)
5. - 8.) 10 M (10)

Sew the ears to the head.

HORN (GREY, 2 X)

- 1.) Cast on 8 ch and make a ring with a sl st. (8)
- 2.) dc 2 tog, 6 dc (7)
- 3.) dc 2 tog, 5 dc (6)
- 4.) dc 2 tog, 4 dc (5)
- 5.) dc 2 tog, 3 dc (4)
- 6.) dc 2 tog, 1 dc, 1 sl st (3)

Sew the horns to the head.

RING-COVER (OFF-WHITE)

37 ch, start with the 4th ch before the hook.

- 1.) 34 tr
2. - 4.) 3 tch, 34 tr

Sew the cover onto the wooden ring with the yarn end.

Sew the head to the ring.

ARM (GREY/OFF-WHITE, 2 X)

Start with grey.

- 1.) cr with 5 dc (5)
- 2.) 2 dc into each st (10)
3. - 4.) 10 dc (10)

Change to off-white.

5. - 12.) 10 dc (10)

Fill the arm with toy stuffing.
Sew the arm to the ring.

COW SPOT (BLACK, 6 X)

- 1.) cr with 6 dc (6)
2.) 2 dc into each st (12)
Sew the cow spots onto the ring.

DORTE (3 PCS) & BEADS

BODY (OFF-WHITE)

- 1.) cr with 6 dc (6)
2.) 2 dc into each st (12)
3.) {1 dc, 2 dc inc} (18)
4.) {2 dc, 2 dc inc} (24)
5.) {3 dc, 2 dc inc} (30)
6. - 12.) 30 dc (30)
13.) {3 dc, dc 2 tog} (24)
14.) 24 dc (24)
15.) {2 dc, dc 2 tog} (18)
16.) 18 dc (18)
17.) {1 dc, dc 2 tog} (12)
18.) 12 dc (12)

Fill the body with toy stuffing.

HEAD (GREY/OFF-WHITE)

Start with grey.

- 1.) cr with 6 dc (6)

- 2.) 2 dc into each st (12)
3.) 2 dc, 3 dc into the next st, 1 dc, 2 dc inc, 2 dc, 2 dc inc, 1 dc, 3 dc into the next st, 2 dc (18)
4. - 5.) 18 dc (18)
6.) dc 2 tog, 3 dc, dc 2 tog, 2 dc, dc 2 tog, 3 dc, dc 2 tog, 2 dc (14)

Change to off-white.

- 7.) 2 dc, 2 dc inc, 6 dc, 2 dc inc, 4 dc (16)
8.) 2 dc inc, 4 dc, 2 dc inc, 4 dc, 2 dc inc, 1 dc, 2 dc inc, 1 dc (21)
9.) {6 dc, 2 dc inc} (24)
10. - 12.) 24 dc (24)

Insert the eyes after 8th row with a distance of 5 sts in between.

- 13.) {2 dc, dc 2 tog} (18)
14.) {1 dc, dc 2 tog} (12)

Fill the head with toy stuffing.

- 15.) {dc 2 tog} (6)

Close the hole by pulling the yarn with a darning needle through the 6 sts.

Use the yarn end to sew the head onto the body.

Shape the head/eye sockets:


Insert the needle beneath the head and up the inner side of the eye. Sew over a stitch at the eye stem, and lead the needle out beneath the head.

Then, insert the needle through the next stitch and up the inner side of the other eye. Again, sew over a stitch at the eye stem, and once again, lead the the needle out beneath the head.

Tighten the thread, allowing the tension to create indentations. Hold the tension and tie two knots to preserve the indentations.

The eye sockets are done.

The shaping of the head/eye sockets can also be done before the eyes are mounted.



EAR (OFF-WHITE/BLACK, 2 X)

Second ear: crochet the 4 first rows in black

- 1.) cr with 4 dc (4)
- 2.) {1 dc, 2 dc inc} (6)
- 3.) {2 dc, 2 dc inc} (8)
4. - 5.) 8 dc (8)

Sew the ears onto the head with the yarn end.

HORN (GREY, 2 X)

5 ch, start with the 2nd ch before the hook.

- 1.) 3 dc, 1 htr

Sew the horns onto the head with the yarn end.

ARM & LEG (GREY/OFF-WHITE, 4 X)

Start with grey.

- 1.) cr with 4 dc (4)
- 2.) 2 dc into each st (8)
- 3.) 8 dc (8)

Change to off-white.

4. - 9.) 8 dc (8)

Fill the arms and legs with toy stuffing.

Use the yarn ends to sew the arms and legs onto the body.

COW SPOTS (BLACK, 7 X)

- 1.) cr with 6 dc (6)
- 2.) 2 dc into each st (12)

Use the yarn ends to sew the cow spots onto the head and body.

BEADS (4 X)

- 1.) 6 dc in magic ring (6)
- 2.) {2 dc in each st} (12)
- 3.) 1 dc, 2 dc in next st,
2 dc, 2 dc in next st,
2 dc, 2 dc in next st,
2 dc, 2 dc in next st, 1 dc (16)
- 4.) 3 dc, 2 dc in next st,
3 dc, 2 dc in next st,
3 dc, 2 dc in next st,
3 dc, 2 dc in next st (20)
- 5.) 4 dc, 2 dc in next st,
10 dc, 2 dc in next st, 4 dc (22)
- 6.) {22 dc} (22)
- 7.) 4 dc, dc 2 tog, 10 dc,
dc 2 tog, 4 dc (20)
- 8.) dc 2 tog, 3 dc, dc 2 tog, 3 dc,
dc 2 tog, 3 dc, dc 2 tog, 3 dc (16)
- 9.) 1 dc, dc 2 tog, 2 dc, dc 2 tog,
2 dc, dc 2 tog, 2 dc, dc 2 tog, 1 dc (12)
- 10.) 6 x dc 2 tog (6)

Stuff and shape the beads.

Bind off.



Good to know

Gohandmade's collection is developed and handcrafted by the expert hands of passionate crocheters. All are crocheted to meet what we find is a medium tightness and what suits the animal.

Hook Size + Tension

Crocheters crochet very differently: some crochet with a hook size 2,0 mm and obtain the same size of design and quality as a person who crochets with a hook size 4,0 mm. We owe this knowledge to the team of crocheters who join us. The key to crochet a specific size is a lot about the crochet style/hands/skills, rather than the size of hook. Therefore, we will recommend a range of hook sizes.



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
