Bohème Velvet "fine": 100% Polyester, 50 g/190 m.

DRESS AND JACKET

Nude Bohème Velvet "fine"

Sand Bohème Velvet "fine"

weight approximately 20 - 25 g

TROUSERS AND JACKET

Jeans Blue Bohème Velvet "fine"

weight approximately 20 - 25 g

MATERIALS:

Eyes 10 mm

Buttons

Filling

Crochet hook (Teddy) 3,0 - 4,0 mm

Crochet hook (Clothes) 2,0 - 3,0 mm

The given amounts of yarn are for guidance only.

REQUIRED MOUNTING STEPS

Eyes in yarn projects (0-3 years)

For projects for children 0-3 years:
Mounting of eyes requires melting of
end pieces and special stitching.

ABBREVIATIONS AND DEFINITIONS

st(s)	Stitch(es)
cr	Magic ring
ch	Chain stitch
t-ch	Turn chain stitch, 1 ch then turn the work
sl st	Slip stitch
dc	Double crochet
tr	Treble crochet
2 dc inc	Increase (2 dc in one st)
dc 2 tog	Decrease (2 dc worked together)
dc 3 tog	Decrease (3 dc worked together)
...	The instructions shown in these brackets must be repeated for the whole round/ row or with the number indicated after x.
(..)	At the end of the line - indicates the total number of stitches.

**If nothing else is specified, work in spiral rounds.
To finish the work, join the round with a sl st.
Leave a 20 cm length of yarn and cut. Pull the
yarn through the stitch.**

*It is recommended that the filling continues on an
ongoing basis as the work progresses.*



Add the eyes between round 12 & 13 and with a space of 6 st between.

Add filling to the head.

Cut the yarn and sew the head together.

Shape the head and the eye sockets:

Thread the yarn about 25 cm. Insert the needle under the chin and up by the inner side of the eye. Stitch over one stitch and bring the needle out at the lower part of the chin. Tighten the thread so that the pressure creates a depression above the eye. To maintain the pressure on the depression, stitch through a couple of stitches at the lower part of the chin. The depression on one eye is now completed. Repeat the process on the opposite eye. See drawing.

SNOUT

With Couture.

| 1.) | cr with 6 dc | (6) |
| 2.) | *2 dc inc* | (12) |
| 3.) | *1 dc, 1 dc inc* | (18) |
| 4.) | *2 dc, 2 dc inc* | (24) |
| 5. - 7.) | 24 dc | (24) |

Add filling to the snout.

Sew the snout onto the head between rounds 14 & 19.

Embroider nose as shown in the pictures.

EARS (2 X)

With Couture.

| 3.) | *1 dc, 2 dc inc* | (18) |

Sew the ears on from round 4 to 10.

Sew the head to the body when all parts have been attached.

ARMS (2 X)

Start with the Soft Bamboo "double".

Add filling to the arms.



Sew the arms to the body.

LEGS (2 X)

Start with the Soft Bamboo "double".

- 1.) Chain 8, 2 dc in 2nd ch from hook,
5 dc, 5 dc in the final ch,
5 dc in ch on the opposite side,
2 dc in the final ch (19)
- 2.) 2 dc inc, 7 dc, 4 x dc inc,
6 dc, 2 dc inc (25)
- 3.) 25 dc (25)

Change to the Couture yarn.

4. - 5.) 25 dc (25)
- 6.) 8 dc, dc 2 tog, dc 3 tog x 2,
dc 2 tog, 7 dc (19)
- 7.) 6 dc, dc 2 tog x 4, 5 dc (15)
8. - 12.) 15 dc (15)
- 13.) 3 dc, 2 dc inc, 7 dc, 2 dc inc, 3 dc (17)
14. - 23.) 17 dc (17)
- 24.) *1 dc, dc 2 tog* x 5,
finish with dc 2 tog (12)
- 25.) *dc 2 tog* (6)

Add filling to the legs.

Sew the legs to the body.

CLOTHES

DRESS (NUDE & SAND)

Start with Bohème Velvet "fine" in the colour Nude.

The dress is crocheted top down in rows.

- 1.) Ch 37, dc 36,
start in 2nd st from hook, 3 t-ch (36)
- 2.) *1 tr, 2 tr inc*, 3 t-ch (54)
- 3.) *2 tr, 2 tr inc *, 1 t-ch (72)

- 4.) 10 dc, ch 6, skip 16sts, (armhole),
20 dc, ch 6, skip 16sts, (armhole),
10 dc, 3 t-ch (52)
5. - 6.) 52 tr, 3 t-ch (52)
- 7.) 10 tr, 2 tr inc, 5 tr, 2 tr inc,
9 tr, 2 tr inc, 9 tr, 2 tr inc,
5 tr, 2 tr inc, 9 tr, 3 t-ch (57)
8. - 10.) 57 tr, 3 t-ch (57)
- 11.) 2 tr inc x 57, 3 t-ch (114)
12. - 14.) 114 tr, 3 t-ch (114)
- 15.) *7 tr, 2 tr inc* x 14, 2 tr, 3 t-ch (128)
16. - 17.) 128 tr, 3 t-ch (128)
- 18.) *8 tr, 2 tr inc* x 14, 2 tr, 1 t-ch (142)
- 19.) 142 dc (142)

Change to Bohème Velvet "fine" in the colour Sand.
Sew buttons on one side of the back.
Button holes are naturally formed through the space between the trebles.

Dress-belt (Sand)

Crochet a string of 150 ch. Bind off. (150)
Pull the strip through every second hole in the 10th row. Close on the back with a bow.

HAIRBAND WITH BOW (SAND)

Crochet with Bohème Velvet "fine" in the colour Sand.


Hairband:

Crochet a string of 150 ch.

Bow:

- 1.) Ch 7 (7)
2. - 22.) Start in 2nd st from hook, 6 dc,
1 t-ch

Fold ends toward each other, crochet together.
The end of the thread is wrapped around the middle of the bow and sewn on the hair band.



JACKET (SAND)

Crochet with Bohème Velvet "fine" in the colour Sand. Jacket is crocheted in rows, top down.

- 1.) Chain 37, start in 2nd st from hook, make 36 dc, 1 t-ch (36)
- 2.) *1 dc, 2 dc inc*, 1 t-ch (54)
- 3.) *2 dc, 2 dc inc*, 1 t-ch (72)
- 4.) 10 dc, ch 10, skip 16 dc (armhole), 20 dc, ch 10, skip 16 dc (armhole), 10 dc, 1 t-ch (60)
- 5 - 14.) 60 dc, 1 t-ch (60)
- 15.) *9 dc, 2 dc inc*, 1 t-ch (66)
- 16 - 19.) 66 dc, 1 t-ch (66)
- 20.) 66 dc (66)

Button holes

Continue crocheting on the jacket.

Along the side of the jacket:

21.) 2 dc, *ch5 ("eye"), 3 dc* x 5, 1 sl st.

Sew buttons on the opposite side, exactly equal to the button holes that were just created ("the eyes").

Sleeves (2 x)

Work on the sleeves starting from the 5th ch in the armholes from the 4th round.

Work in spirals:

- 1.) 5 dc on the chain of armhole, 16 dc along arm gap, 5 dc on ch (26)
- 2 - 19.) 26 dc



TROUSERS (JEANS BLUE)

Crochet with Bohème Velvet "fine" in the colour Jeans Blue.

Legs (2x)

- 1.) Ch 30 (30)
- Close to a ring with 1 sl st.
From here: work in spiral.
- 2 - 9.) 30 dc (30)
- The first leg is finished off here.

Second leg

Work according to 1 st leg, but **do not** cut yarn.

Join legs

- 10.) Ch 2, 30 dc on first pant leg 1, 2 dc on chain loop, 30 dc on second pant leg, 2 dc on the other side of the chain loop. (64)
- 11 - 14.) 64 dc (64)
- 15.) 29 dc, *2 dc tog* x 3, 27 dc, *2 dc inc* x 2 (63)
- 16.) 2 dc inc, 62 dc (64)
- 17 - 18.) 64 dc (64)
- 19.) 15 dc, *2 dc tog* x 2, 26 dc, *2 dc tog* x 2, 15 dc (60)
- 20 - 21.) 60 dc (60)
- 22.) 28 dc, 2 dc tog, 29 dc, 2 dc inc, (60)
- 23 - 24.) 60 dc (60)

Strips and front

Ch 40, turn work, crochet 34 dc, start in 6th st from hook ("eye"), 2 dc (placed the strips on the back of the trousers),

Ch 40, turn work, crochet 34 dc, start in 6th st from hook ("eye"), 35 dc (on the edge of trousers), 1 t-ch, Continue in rows.

10 dc, 1 t-ch x 4

Sew buttons on both corners of trousers front.

JACKET (JEANS BLUE)

Crochet with Bohème Velvet "fine" in the colour Jeans Blue.

Jacket is crocheted in rows, top down.

- 1.) Chain 37, start in 2nd st from hook, make 36 dc (36)
- 2.) *1 dc, 2 dc inc*, 1 t-ch (54)
- 3.) *2 dc, 2 dc inc*, 1 t-ch (72)
- 4.) 10 dc, ch 10, skip 16 dc (armhole), 20 dc, ch 10, skip 16 dc (armhole), 10 dc, 1 t-ch (60)
- 5 - 12.) 60 dc, 1 t-ch (60)
- 13.) *9 dc, 2 dc inc*, 1 t-ch (66)
- 14 - 17.) 66 dc, 1 t-ch (66)
- 18.) 66 dc (66)

Button holes

Continue crocheting on the jacket.

Work on the jacket's side upwards:

- 19.) 2 dc, *5 ch ("eye"), 3 dc* x 4, 1 t-ch

Sew buttons on the opposite side, exactly equal to the button holes that were just created ("the eyes").

Sleeves (2 x)

Work on the sleeves starting from the 5th ch in the armholes from the 4th round.

- 1.) 5 dc on the chain, 16 dc along arm gap, 5 dc on the chain. (26)
2. - 19.) 26 dc (26)





Good to know

Hook Size + Tension

Crocheters crochet very differently: some crochet with a hook size 2,0 mm and obtain the same size of design and quality as a person who crochets with a hook size 4,0 mm. We owe this knowledge to the team of crocheters who join us.

The key to crochet a specific size is a lot about the crochet style/hands/skills, rather than the size of hook. Therefore, we will recommend a range of hook sizes.



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
